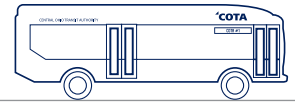

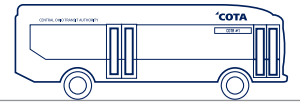
RECEIVING YOUR DISCOUNT:

When you board the Zoo Bus, kindly ask your Operator for a **Zoo Bus coupon**. They will distribute one per customer. Once you arrive at the Zoo, head to the admission window to present the coupon to verify your discount eligibility. If you are a COTA Mainstream customer, show your COTA-issued Mainstream ID Card at the window instead. **It's that easy!**

MAKE SURE TO:

- Arrive at your stop five minutes early.
- Be visible — step outside of the shelter if you are in one and remain close to the transit stop sign.
- Buses cannot make change, so **bring exact cash for each leg of your trip.**
- Due to fare capping, digital payment methods such as Tap to Pay or the Transit app can only be used for one rider, so exact cash is recommended for groups and families.
- COTA Smartcards offer a family account option, allowing you to register multiple Smartcards within one account and pay for all your riders with the same payment method.

Zoo Bus serves all stops in downtown Columbus. Outside of downtown, it only stops at Griggs Dam, the Dublin Park and Ride and the Zoo.
