## **COTA Hosting Transit System Redesign Public Meetings and Seeking Feedback on Plan**

### ***TSR Public Comment Meetings Scheduled for Nov. 4 & 12***

**COLUMBUS, OH**—The Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) will host two public comment meetings in November regarding the Transit System Redesign (TSR).

COTA completed a comprehensive review of its bus system in 2014, with the goal of improving service to meet the changing needs of the region. The TSR is the resulting plan that will make central Ohio's bus system easier to use, more frequent, and more direct. The changes are being implemented over a three year period, which began in January 2015.

Many COTA lines are proposed to have route changes and/or new numbers, and some lines may be consolidated. Join us at a public meeting to learn about these improvements, and provide feedback as COTA finalizes the new network.
